PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF LAWYERS' COMMITTEE FOR CIVIL RIGHTS UNDER LAW'S MOTION TO COMPEL COMPLIANCE WITH THE COURT'S AUGUST 30, 2017 ORDER AND FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATE RELIEF

The Court, having considered Plaintiff Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law's Motion to Compel Compliance with the Court's August 30, 2017 Order and for Additional Appropriate Relief ("Motion") and any opposition thereto, and finding that good cause appears, orders as follows:

The Motion is hereby GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that within 14 days from the date of this Order, Defendants shall file a supplemental Vaughn index that individually logs records that were previously categorized, that includes all text messages, and that includes records that pre-date May 11, 2017. In addition, as appropriate relief to address concerns about the completeness of the index, the Court further orders that the Lawyers' Committee may notice up to \_\_\_ depositions of Commissioners [AND/OR] Commissioners shall submit declarations regarding their efforts to preserve, collect, and index records related to the Commission.
